Camp Rules

1. Modest attire should be worn at all times.
 - a. Men should wear shirts except for at swim times.
 - b. Women should wear a one-piece swim suit at swim times, if a two-piece suit is worn, please wear a shirt over it. Women must wear proper undergarments.
2. Kitchen staff only is allowed in the kitchen.
3. Upright Christian conduct is expected of campers at all times. No irreverent symbols, gestures, or language is allowed.
4. No smoking, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or drugs allowed on campground (rooms, roads, and lake).
5. No pets, electronics, magazines, or fireworks allowed.
6. Any unclaimed personal items left at camp will be thrown away.
7. Boys and Girls should keep to their own dorms.
8. Children are not allowed in the dorms without your leaders or an adult's permission.
9. Men should not wear hats inside or earrings while at camp.
10. All campers should come to the lodge when the bell is rung.
11. At mealtime, take only the food you can eat...seconds will be offered at mealtime once everyone has been fed. Put the proper items in the assigned trashcans (food/fluids).
12. All children must wear life jackets during swim time unless they pass the swim test with the recognized adult life guard. All boaters must wear lifejackets.
13. Children may not walk on John Ramsey Rd or walk off campgrounds.
14. Be watchful of critters in the woods, on the trails, and in the lake.
15. If you are under 18 and have driven to camp, please keep your vehicle locked and turn your keys into a Camp convener.
16. Trash at the campgrounds must be picked up before campers leave.
